

AN ACT

BROADENING THE OPPORTUNITIES OF FILIPINO YOUTH BY ALLOWING GRADUATES OF K-12 ENHANCED EDUCATION IN THE PHILIPPINE NATIONAL POLICE, AMENDING FOR THE PURPOSE THE PNP LAW, R.A. 6975 AS AMENDED BY R.A. 8551

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

- Section 1. It is a declared policy of the State that the youth plays a vital role in nation-building and shall promote and protect their physical, moral, spiritual, intellectual, and social well-being. It shall inculcate in the youth patriotism and nationalism, and encourage their involvement in public and civic affairs. Through this legislation, the opportunities for Filipino youth will be broadened by opening the admission of the Philippine National Police (PNP) to graduates of the K-12 enhanced education program.
 - Sec. 2. The existing provisions on the General Qualifications for Appointment in the PNP in RA 6975, as amended by RA 8551, is hereby amended to read as follows:
 - "a) A citizen of the Philippines;

- b) A person of good moral conduct;
- c) Must have passed the psychiatric/psychological, drug and physical tests to be administered by the PNP or by any NAPOLCOM accredited government hospital for the purpose of determining physical and mental health;

1	d)	Must [possess a formal-baccalaureate degree from a recognized
2		institution of learning] HAVE COMPLETED THE K-12
3		ENHANCED EDUCATION PROGRAM;
4	e)	Must be eligible in accordance with the standards set by the
5		Commission;
6	f)	Must not have been dishonorably discharged from the military
7		employment or dismissed for cause from any civilian position in the
8		Government;
9	g)	Must not have been convicted by final judgment of an offense or
LO		crime involving moral turpitude;
11	h)	Must be at least one meter and sixty-two centimeters (1.62 m.) in
12		height for male and one meter and fifty-seven centimeters (1.57
13		m.) for female;
14	i)	Must weight not more or less than five kilograms (5 kgs.) from the
15		standard weight corresponding to his or her height, age, and sex;
16		and,
17	j)	For a new applicant, must not be less than twenty-one (21) nor
18		more than thirty (30) years of age: except for the last qualification,
19		the above-enumerated qualifications shall be continuing in
20		character and an absence of any one of them at any given time
21		shall be a ground for separation or retirement from the service:
22		Provided, that PNP members who are already in the service upon
23		the effectivity of this Act shall be given at least two (2) more years
24		to obtain the minimum educational qualification and one (1) year to
25		satisfy the weight requirement.
